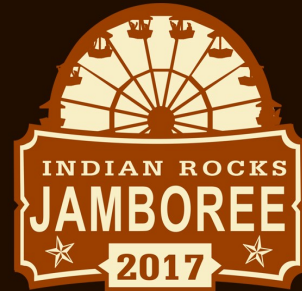

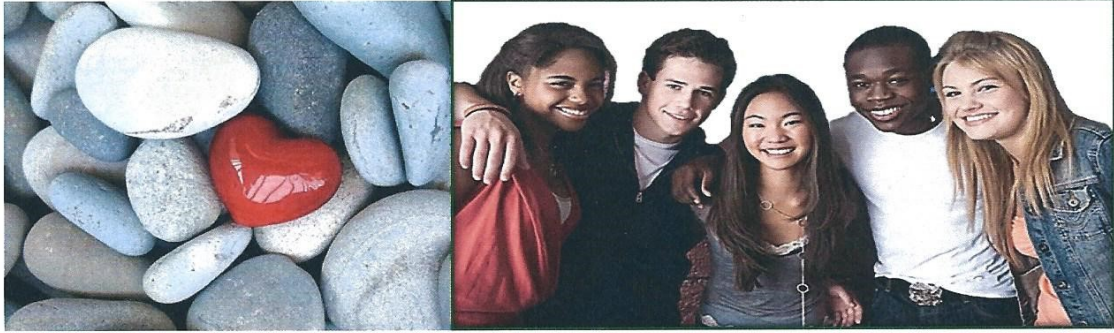

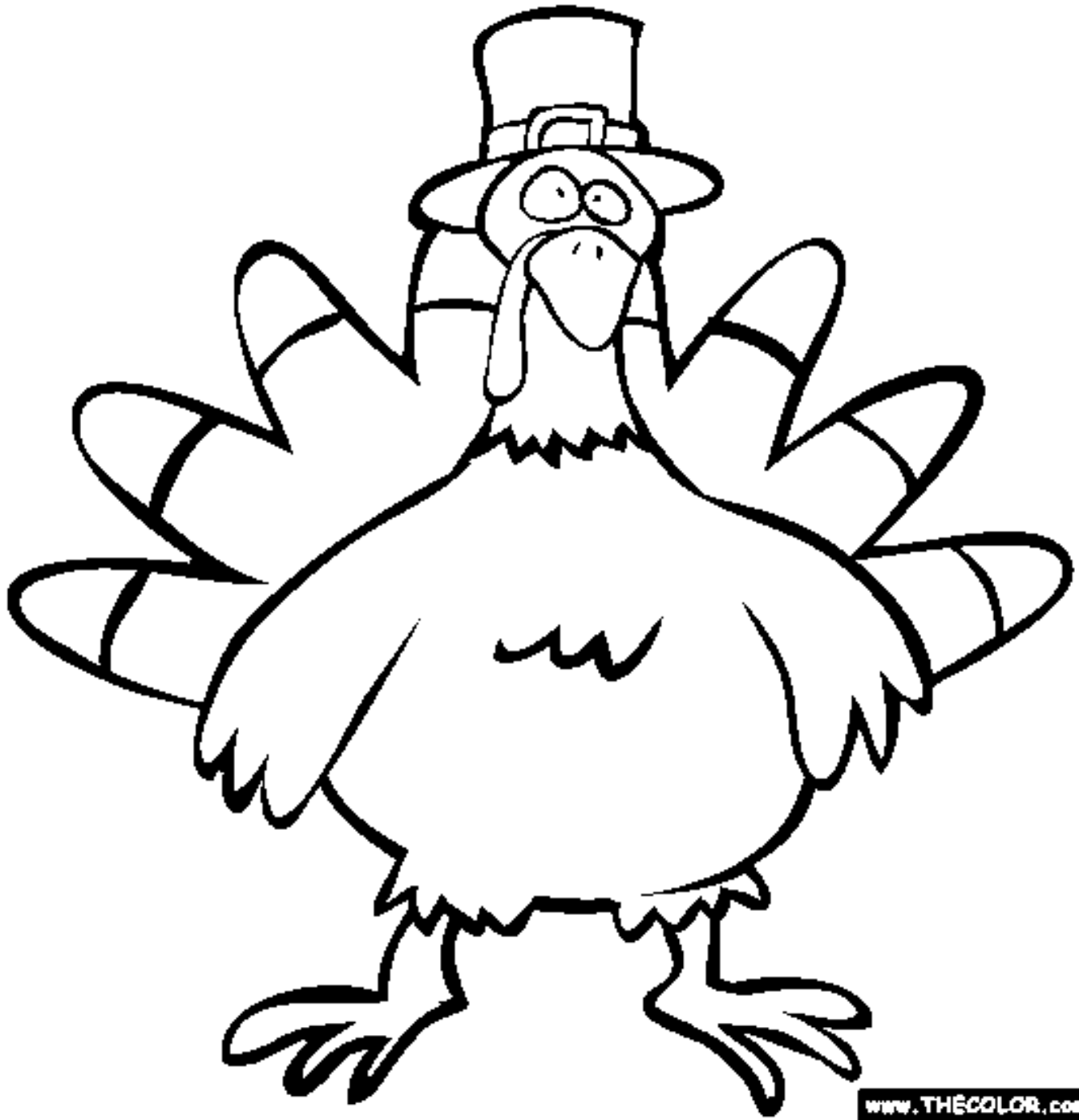
Would you like to promote wellness by learning about the brain and its influence on thoughts, feelings and behavior?

Florida Children's Mental Health System of Care Grant coordinator and NAMI Pinellas will present a wellness workshop designed for youth aged 10 to 16 years old to give youth an exciting opportunity to learn about mental illness. We will confront the myths that reinforce stigma, as we raise social awareness that biology, not a character flaw, causes mental illness. Throughout the workshop, youth learn symptoms and indicators of mental illness, and are given ideas about how to help themselves, friends, or family members who may be in need of support. The presentation portion includes personal testimony from a peer living with a mental illness about his/her journey to recovery. Youth will visit several hands on learning centers to discover more about the frequency of mental illness, connect with Mental Illness by creating a model brain using play-doh and painting a kindness rock and take action on behalf of Mental Illness by creating an ambassadors program. This program will ensure our participants leave with tools to support those affected by mental illness through education and advocacy.
